Serving as an Iowa City Area Business Partnership Ambassador is an exciting and rewarding experience. Ambassadors celebrate the success of area businesses and organizations, network with members, and invite other businesses to join the Business Partnership.

Please answer the following questions with as much detail as possible. After completing the application, you must attend a meet-and-greet with current Ambassadors. This is an informal interview for the Committee. The final admission decision will be made by the Executive Committee the week following these meet-and-greets.

An Ambassador in good standing must:

- 1. Participate in 2-3 events per month or 24 events throughout the year, including ribbon cuttings, ground breakings, award presentations, Business PMs and/or monthly meetings
- 2. In good faith, make a commitment to the Committee for **two years** of service.
- 3. Attend Ambassador Orientation
- 4. Embrace the recruitment of businesses to join the Iowa City Area Business Partnership
- 5. Purchase a navy-blue blazer to wear at Ambassador events

What is the Ambassador Committee?

- The Ambassadors is a committee comprised of approximately 30 volunteers representing
 different businesses throughout the community. These Ambassadors also represent the
 Business Partnership by attending and facilitating at business ribbon cuttings, Business PMs,
 and other connections events.
- Ambassadors serve two-year terms and are eligible to become emeritus after two years of being in good standing.
- Ambassadors are given an Ambassador patch to place on a navy blue blazer. The blazer must be worn at all Business Partnership events and must be purchased by the Ambassador.
- Ambassadors must be employed by a current Business Partnership member business. No
 more than one Ambassador from a single member business may be selected into the active
 Ambassador committee, unless otherwise determined by the Executive Committee.
 Exceptions can be made for larger organizations, where the decision is to be made by the

- Executive Committee on a case-by-case basis; this number does not include Emeritus Ambassadors.
- Emeritus Ambassadors are Ambassadors who have already served a two-year term and are no longer a current Ambassador. They receive all communication and invitations but do not have attendance requirements.
- Dues: There are currently no dues required to be paid by either the Ambassador or Emeritus member. (4/2021)
